

**Mathematics** – Capacity and volume, Mass, Time, 3x and 4x multiplication and division

**We are learning to:**

- Estimate and measure temperature, capacity and volume using correct units.
- Be able to weigh and compare the mass of objects.
- Tell the time on an analogue clock with 5 minute intervals.
- Know multiplication facts for the 3 and 4 times tables.
- Use bar models to solve mathematical problems.

**Science** – Living things and their Habitats

**We are learning to:**

- Investigate a local habitat and present our findings.
- Select and use scientific equipment appropriately.
- Identify and create food chains to show how living things in a habitat depend on each other.

**We are learning to:**

- Understand the teachings and traditions of Sikhism.
- Compare Sikh beliefs to those of other faiths.

**Computing** – We are zoologists

**We are learning to:**

- Take photos and store these as digital content.
- Manipulate images using a computer.

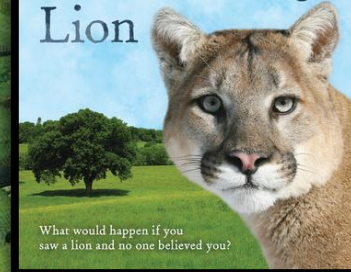
**Reading**
