

Maths – Decimals, Perimeter and Area

We are learning to:

- Recognise and write decimal equivalents.
- Find the effect of dividing by 10 or 100.
- Round a decimal to the nearest whole number.
- Add and subtract decimal numbers.
- Solve problems including decimal numbers.
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in centimetres and metres.
- Find the area of rectilinear shapes by counting squares.

Science – Living Things and their Habitats

We are learning to:

- Group vertebrates and invertebrates in a range of ways using a classification key.
- Recognise environmental dangers to animals.

R.E – Pilgrimage

We are learning to:

- Explore whether Christians should go on a pilgrimage.
- Understand the importance of Holy Communion to Christians.

French – Classroom

We are learning to:

- Identify classroom objects and colours and say your age.
- Recognise and repeat classroom instructions.

Writing

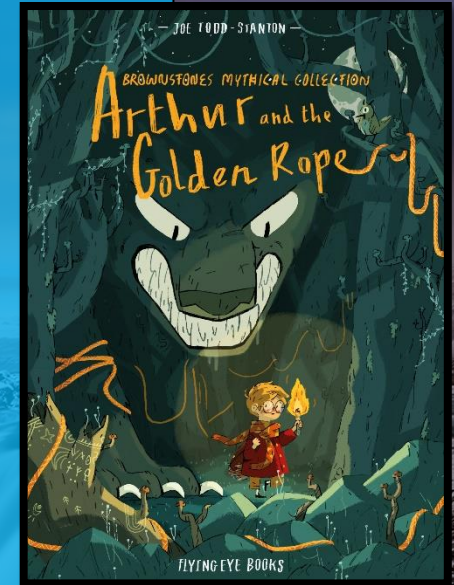
- Use drama and freeze frames to explore a book.
